1989, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Second Schedule—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from clause 2 (b) the expression “0.87”, and substituting the expression “1.46”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989 by increasing the charge for the inspection of sawn timber to be exported from 87c per cubic metre to \$1.46 per cubic metre.
