### Notice

- 1 **Title**  
This is the Fisheries (Kaikoura–Wakatu Quay Area Closure) Notice 2002.
- 2 **Commencement**  
This notice comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3 **Expiry**  
This notice expires with the close of 2 years after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 4 **Interpretation**  
In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires,—  
**Kaikoura–Wakatu Quay area** means that area of the South Island fisheries waters that lies within an area defined by a line commencing at a point on the eastern side of the north wharf at point 42°24.77'E, 173°42.17'S then heading in a north easterly direction to a rock at point 42°24.65'E, 173°42.48'S, thence in a south easterly direction to the landward of St Kilda

rocks at point 42°24.81'E, 173°42.77'S, thence in a south westerly direction to a rock at point 42°25.12'E, 173°42.48'S returning to the shore due east of the last mentioned point.

## 5 Area closed for 2 years

No person may take any species of fish, aquatic life, or seaweed from the Kaikoura–Wakatu Quay area while this notice is in force.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, prohibits the taking of any species of fish, aquatic life, or seaweed from the Kaikoura–Wakatu Quay area while the notice is in force. The notice expires 2 years after its notification in the *Gazette*.
