### Order

#### 1 Title

- (1) This order is the Fisheries (Cost Recovery Levies) Amendment Order 2000.
- (2) In this order, the Fisheries (Cost Recovery Levies) Order (No 2) 1999<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal order”.

**2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Monthly levies on Northland scallops**

- (1) Part A of the Schedule of the principal order is amended by omitting the item relating to SCA1, and substituting the following item:

- (2) This clause applies to the monthly levy payable for August and September 2000.

**4 Annual levy on Coromandel scallops**

- (1) Part C of the Schedule of the principal order is amended by omitting the item relating to Coromandel scallops, and substituting the following item:

Coromandel scallops	2,485.56

- (2) This clause applies to the annual levy payable for the fishing year ending on 30 September 2000.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order amends the Fisheries (Cost Recovery Levies) Order (No 2) 1999 by reducing the levies payable on Northland and Coromandel scallops for the balance of the 1999–2000 fishing year. The reduction reflects the over-recovery in the earlier part of the fishing year of costs relating to research projects on stock assessments in the 2 fisheries.

The monthly levy payable on each tonne of quota for Northland scallops is reduced to zero with effect from the August 2000 monthly levy.

The annual levy per tonne of individual catch limit for Coromandel scallops, which is payable in monthly instalments, is reduced to a level that means that the monthly instalments will also reduce to zero with effect from August 2000.
