1 Title

- (1) This order is the Fisheries (Over-Fishing Thresholds for Quota Management Stocks) Amendment Order 2004.
- (2) In this order, the Fisheries (Over-Fishing Thresholds for Quota Management Stocks) Order 2001¹ is called “the principal order”.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 October 2004.

3 Over-fishing threshold for North Island long-finned and short-finned freshwater eel

The Schedule of the principal order is amended by omitting the items relating to long-finned freshwater eel, and short-finned freshwater eel, and substituting, respectively, the following items:
