



**THE GOODS-SERVICE CHARGES TRIBUNAL EMERGENCY
REGULATIONS 1943, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Goods-service Charges Tribunal Emergency Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Goods-service Charges Tribunal Emergency Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 12, the following regulation :—

“ 12A. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing regulations, the Tribunal may from time to time give to the Commissioner a notification in writing of its intention to review or alter the charges in all goods-services or in any group of goods-services (including any charges payable under any contract) consequent on the making by the Court of Arbitration under Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942† of any amendment of the provisions of any award or industrial agreement relating to rates of remuneration of workers in the goods transport industry.

“ (2) Where any notification is given to the Commissioner under this regulation, the provisions of Regulation 11 and Regulation 12 hereof shall apply so far as they are applicable, subject to the following provisions :—

“ (a) Subclause (2) of Regulation 11 shall not apply :

“ (b) Subclause (4) of Regulation 12 shall not apply :

“ (c) In the case of a decision of the Tribunal altering any charges under a contract the Commissioner may either give public notice of the decision as prescribed by subclause (1) of Regulation 12 or give written notice of the decision to the parties to the contract and to such other person or persons as he may consider to be affected thereby.”
