REGULATIONS 1944, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 31st day of

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Service Appeals Emergency Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Service Appeals Emergency Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 3, the following new regulation :—

“3A. Any officer or member to whom Regulation 3 hereof applies shall have a right to appeal, by due notice forwarded in accordance with that regulation, against any appointment made pursuant to an appeal that has been allowed at any time after he commenced his full-time service in any of His Majesty’s Forces (whether before or after the commencement of these regulations).”
