### Regulations

#### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Goods Service Vehicle (Constructional) Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Goods Service Vehicle (Constructional) Regulations 1936<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2005.

**Explanatory note**

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2005, amend the Goods Service Vehicle (Constructional) Regulations 1936. The amendment revokes the regulation that the Land Transport Rule: Heavy Vehicles 2004 (31002) has replaced.
