1. Title—This order may be cited as the Health and Disability Services Amendment Act 1998 Commencement Order 1998.

2. Commencement of section 4 of Health and Disability Services Amendment Act 1998—Section 4 of the Health and Disability Services Amendment Act 1998 comes into force on 24 September 1998.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 24 September 1998, section 4 of the Health and Disability Services Amendment Act 1998. That section prevents a hospital and health service that has a net loss in respect of the 1997/98 income year or any previous income year from offsetting that net loss against its net income in the 1998/99 income year or any subsequent income year.
