



**THE HAWKE'S BAY CREMATORIUM (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1945**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hawke's Bay Crematorium Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hawke's Bay Crematorium (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1945.
2. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941\* shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Hawke's Bay Crematorium Board established under the Hawke's Bay Crematorium Act, 1944, its Chairman and its members.
3. The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941\* shall be after the rate of £1 5s. a day.
4. The rate of the mileage-allowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941\* for journeys performed in a motor-vehicle shall be 8d. a mile.
5. The amount payable in respect of actual garage expenses referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941\* shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night.
