## THE HARBOUR BOARDS (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1945

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of June, 1945

Present:

#### HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Harbour Boards (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1945.

2. The Harbour Boards Travelling-allowance Regulations 1934\* are revoked.

**3.** These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941<sup>†</sup> shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to Harbour Boards within the meaning of the Harbours Act, 1923, and members thereof.

5. The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941 $\dagger$  shall be at the rate of £1 per day.

6. The mileage-allowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941<sup>+</sup> for journeys performed in a horse-drawn vehicle or motor-vehicle shall be at a rate not exceeding 8d. per mile.

7. The actual garage expenses referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941<sup>†</sup> shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night.

9. Any Harbour Board may, with the sanction of the Audit Office, pay to any member of the Board, in lieu of the payments authorized by the foregoing regulations, a sum not exceeding the necessary expenses actually incurred and paid by that member.
