THE HARBOUR BOARDS REPRESENTATION ORDER 1959

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of October 1959

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Harbour Boards Representation Order 1959.

2. The First Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950, as substituted by section 20 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act 1959, is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting so much of the second column as relates to the Gisborne Harbour Board, and substituting the following words: "Four by the electors of the City of Gisborne; five by the electors of the Counties of Cook and Wairoa whose qualification is within the harbour district; and three by the electors of the County of Waikohu whose qualification is within the harbour district":
- (b) By omitting from so much of the second column as relates to the Lyttelton Harbour Board the words "and of the Town District of Leeston".

3. Each local authority named in the third column of the First Schedule hereto is hereby selected and appointed to be the principal local authority for the purposes of the election of the member or members of the Harbour Board who are to be elected by the electors of the combined district specified in the second column opposite the name of the local authority.

4. The orders specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Clause 2 amends the First Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950 (setting out the constitution of Harbour Boards) by—

- (a) Replacing the provisions relating to the Gisborne Harbour Board with provisions restoring those prescribed by Order in Council dated 29 August 1955 (*Gazette*, 15 September 1955, p. 1429).
- (b) Omitting from the provisions relating to the Lyttelton Harbour Board the reference to the Town District of Lecston, which has since been merged in the County of Ellesmere.

Clause 3 and the First Schedule consolidate the existing Orders in Council appointing the principal local authorities for the purposes of the election of members of Harbour Boards to be elected by the electors of combined districts. The existing law is not amended.

The order also includes a revocation of some Orders in Council altering the representation on certain Harbour Boards, consequentially on provisions as to the members of Boards now appearing in the Second Schedule to the Harbours Amendment Act 1959.
