PURSUANT to the King George the Fifth Memorial Children's Health Camps Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Health Camps Imprest Order 1959.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1959.

2. The amount that the King George the Fifth Memorial Children's Health Camps Board may fix as the maximum amount that may be held at any time in any specified imprest account established by the Board shall not exceed the sum of £4,000, instead of the sum of £2,000 specified in section 14 (3) of the King George the Fifth Memorial Children's Health Camps Act 1953.
