THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (DENTAL OFFICERS)
REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Dental Officers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Dental Officers) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

Commencement

2. (1) The scales of salaries specified in the Schedule to regulation 4 of the special regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 hereof) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns of that Schedule headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 July 1962" and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1962".

(2) Except as aforesaid, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation, and substituting the following Schedule:

“(6) A Board may permit all or part of the annual leave accruing in respect of a year of employment to be postponed to the next following year, but annual leave entitlement at any time shall not exceed the total of annual leave accruing in respect of two years of employment.”
