ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

Title and Commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1961.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclauses (2), (3), and (4), and substituting the following subclauses:

“(2) For the purpose of computing the rate of salary payable to an employee according to that scale, unless otherwise expressly provided in these regulations, the rate of salary during the first year shall be the rate stated as the minimum in the scale, and during every succeeding year the employee shall receive an increase annually to the rate next above that being received according to that scale up to the rate stated as the maximum in the scale.

“(3) Where only one rate is stated in the scale, the employee shall receive that rate of salary.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The special regulations, which govern the employment of different occupational groups and which form part of these regulations, no longer express salary increases by way of increments. The method now adopted is to set out in the scale each annual increase of salary. This regulation amends the principal regulations to give effect to the new method.
