**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (ENGINEERS)
REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

Commencement

2. (1) The scales of salaries specified in regulation 4 of the special regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 hereof) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns therein headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 July 1962" and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1962".

(2) Except as aforesaid, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) Subject to the provisions of regulations 5 to 10 of the special regulations (as amended by these regulations), a whole-time engineer shall receive a yearly rate of salary according to the scale of salary from time to time determined in each case by the Grading Committee, with the approval of the Minister, that scale being one of the eight following:

4. The special regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 5, and substituting the following regulation:

“5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in regulation 4 hereof, the Grading Committee may, with the approval of the Minister, determine in the case of an engineer who, in the opinion of the Grading Committee, is a person of exceptional qualifications and training or of exceptional experience a yearly rate of salary exceeding the maximum of £2,200 from 26 July 1962 and specified in subclause (1) of regulation 4, but in no case exceeding £2,340 from 26 July 1962.”

5. Regulation 6 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (8) the words “subject to prior application by” and substituting the words “made on the application of”.

6. Regulation 7 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words “1st day of April 1960” wherever they occur, and substituting the words “26th day of July 1962”.

7. Regulation 9 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) This regulation shall apply to shift engineers whose yearly rate of salary does not exceed £1,250 from 26 July 1962 and £1,260 from 1 August 1962.”

8. Regulation 11 of the special regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

“(6) A Board may permit all or part of the annual leave accruing in respect of a year of employment to be postponed to the next following year but annual leave entitlement at any time shall not exceed the total of annual leave accruing in respect of two years of employment.”

These regulations provide amended conditions of employment for engineers employed by Hospital Boards.
