**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (DIETITIANS) REGULATIONS  
1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Dietitians) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Dietitians) Regulations 1963\* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

*Commencement*

2. (1) The scales of salaries and wages specified in the Schedule to regulation 4 of the special regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 hereof) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the columns of that Schedule headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1961", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 October 1961", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1962", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 July 1962", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1962", and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1963".

(2) Except as aforesaid, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation, and substituting the following Schedule:

4. The special regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 5, and substituting the following regulation:

"5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in regulation 4 hereof, the Grading Committee may, with the approval of the Minister, determine in the case of a grade dietitian who in the opinion of the Grading Committee is a person of exceptional qualifications and training or of exceptional experience a yearly rate of salary exceeding the maximum specified in regulation 4 hereof of £1,380 on and from 1 April 1961, £1,410 on and from 1 October 1961, £1,435 on and from 1 April 1962, £1,470 on and from 26 July 1962, £1,480 on and from 1 August 1962, and £1,505 on and from 1 April 1963, but in no case exceeding £1,438 on and from 1 April 1961, £1,468 on and from 1 October 1961, £1,486 on and from 1 April 1962, £1,521 on and from 26 July 1962, £1,531 on and from 1 August 1962, and £1,555 on and from 1 April 1963."

5. Regulation 6 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (8) the words "the subject of a prior application by" and substituting the words "made on the application of".

6. Regulation 7 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words "1st day of April 1960" wherever they occur, and substituting the words "1st day of April 1961".

7. Regulation 14 of the special regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

"(6) A Board may permit all or part of the annual leave accruing in respect of a year of employment to be postponed to the next following year, but annual leave entitlement at any time shall not exceed the total of annual leave accruing in respect of two years of employment."
