**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (PHYSIOTHERAPISTS)  
REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Physiotherapists) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Physiotherapists) Regulations 1963\* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

*Commencement*

2. (1) The scales of salaries and wages specified in the Schedule to regulation 4 of the special regulations, as substituted by regulation 3 hereof, shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the columns of that Schedule headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1961", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 October 1961", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1962", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 July 1962", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1962", and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1963".

(2) Except as aforesaid, these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. (1) Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation, and substituting the following Schedule:

(2) The provisions of subclause (2) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations shall not apply to persons employed as physiotherapy aids during the period commencing on 1 April 1961 and ending with 31 March 1963 and the rates of salaries and wages payable to such persons shall be determined by the Director-General within the scale of salaries and wages prescribed for physiotherapy aids in the Schedule to subclause (1) of this regulation.

4. Regulation 10 of the special regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following subclause:

“(7) A Board may permit all or part of the annual leave accruing in respect of a year of employment to be postponed to the next following year but annual leave entitlement at any time shall not exceed the total of annual leave accruing in respect of two years of employment.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide amended scales of salaries and wages and other conditions of employment for physiotherapists, students, and physiotherapy aids employed by Hospital Boards.
