**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (ORTHOPAEDIC
TECHNICIANS) REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Orthopaedic Technicians) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Orthopaedic Technicians) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

Commencement

2. (1) The scales of salaries and wages specified in the Schedule to regulation 4 of the special regulations, as substituted by regulation 3 hereof, shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns therein headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 July 1962" and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1962".

(2) Regulation 4 of these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of July 1962.

(3) Except as aforesaid, these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to subclause (1) and substituting the following Schedule:

“(b) The maximum yearly rates specified in paragraph (a) of this clause are subject to the provisions of paragraphs (c) and (d) of this clause.		
“(c) Where a person appointed as a journeyman has had at least 12 months’ experience in a related trade after completing his apprenticeship in that trade, the Board may, at its discretion, pay him the salary for the second year after three months’ service on the salary for the first year.		
“(d) The salary of a journeyman who has not completed an apprenticeship either in a related trade or in an orthopaedic depart- ment shall not be advanced beyond the rate for the first year until he has served such time as would have been necessary to complete such an apprenticeship.		
“4. Trainee—		
“(a) First year	360	365

“(f) The yearly rates specified in the foregoing provisions of this clause are subject to the provisions of paragraph (g) of this clause.		
“(g) Subject to the prior approval of the Director- General, a commencing salary higher than the first year salary may be paid having regard to the age, educational qualifica- tions, and experience of the person to be appointed as a trainee.”		

4. Regulation 5 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (1) the expression “13s.”, and substituting the expression “13s. 4d.”.

5. The special regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6, and substituting the following regulation:

“Lodging Allowances for Certain Trainees

“6. Where in the opinion of a Board a trainee is reasonably required by his circumstances to live away from home, the Board may pay him a lodging allowance according to the following scale, namely:

6. Regulation 10 of the special regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following subclause:

“(6) A Board may permit all or part of the annual leave accruing in respect of a year of employment to be postponed to the next following year but annual leave entitlement at any time shall not exceed the total of annual leave accruing in respect of two years of employment.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide amended scales of salaries and wages and other conditions of employment of orthopaedic technicians employed by Hospital Boards.
