1 Title

This order is the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (Extension of Transitional Provisions) Order 2004.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Extension of expiry date of transitional provisions

The expiry of Parts XI to XV and the Seventh Schedule of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 is extended to the close of 1 July 2006.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after its notification in the *Gazette*, extends the expiry date of a number of transitional provisions in the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996.

The effect of the order is that the expiry date for Parts XI to XV and the Seventh Schedule is extended to 1 July 2006. The order does not apply to Part XVI because that Part expired on 29 July 2001.
