



# Immigration Amendment Regulations 2003

## Order in Council

At Wellington this 17th day of February 2003

Pursuant to section 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

## Regulations

### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Immigration Amendment Regulations 2003.
- (2) In these regulations, the Immigration Regulations 1999<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

### 2 Commencement

- (1) Regulation 4 comes into force on 24 March 2003.

- (2) The rest of these regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Persons exempt from requirement to obtain temporary visa**

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from clause B.1(b)(ii) the item “Zimbabwe”.

**4 Fees**

Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (c) of item 3, and substituting the following item:

(c) student visa	140	140	170	200

**5 Revocation**

Regulations 2(1) and 4 of the Immigration Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2002 (SR 2002/417) are revoked.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Immigration Regulations 1999 to—

- remove citizens of Zimbabwe from the list of persons who are exempt from the requirement to obtain a temporary visa for visits to New Zealand not exceeding 3 months, with effect from the day after the date of notification of these regulations in the *Gazette*; and
  - increase by \$40 the various fees payable on application for a student visa with effect from 24 March 2003, and revoke a fee increase for applications for limited purpose visas for study purposes that would otherwise have come into force on that date.
