### Regulations

- Title**  
These regulations are the Immigration Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2006.
- Commencement**  
These regulations come into force on 12 October 2006.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Immigration Regulations 1999.

**4 Schedule 1 amended**

Subpart A of Part 1 of Schedule 1 is amended by omitting clause 2 and substituting the following clause:

- “2 Persons who hold a current permanent residence visa (including a resident return visa) issued by the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia.”

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Immigration Regulations 1999, which specifies persons who are exempt from the requirement to obtain a visa to enter New Zealand. The amendment, which takes effect on 12 October 2006, assures visa-free entry to persons holding a permanent residence visa issued by the Government of Australia, as well as those holding resident return visas.
