PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Infectious Diseases Order 1959.
(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Taeniasis and cysticercosis are hereby declared to be notifiable infectious diseases within the meaning of the Health Act 1956.

(2) Part I of the First Schedule to the Health Act 1956 is hereby accordingly amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following items:

Cysticercosis.
Taeniasis.
