THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (STORAGE-BATTERY MANUFACTURE) AMENDMENT NOTICE 1938.

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Storage-battery Manufacture) Amendment Notice 1938.

2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following:—

The manufacture and/or assembly of secondary or storage cells and batteries, commonly known as wet batteries, or any part or parts thereof.

3. The notice heretofore given by me under the said section in respect of the aforesaid industry and cited as the Industry Licensing (Storage-battery Manufacture) Notice 1938* is amended by substituting for the words "1st day of December, 1938," wherever those words occur in the said notice the words "1st day of April, 1939".

4. Except as modified by this notice, the aforesaid notice shall continue in full force and effect.
