THE INSPECTION OF BOILERS ORDER 1958

COBHAM, Governor-General

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Inspection of Boilers Order 1958.
2. Boilers of the class referred to in the Schedule hereto shall be inspected only once in every two years.

SCHEDULE

CLASS OF BOILERS EXEMPTED FROM YEARLY INSPECTION

ANY boiler consisting of a vessel (other than a container for transport) which is used as a receiver for compressed air, which does not exceed 10 cubic feet in capacity, and which is supplied with compressed air exclusively from a compressor or other apparatus in which the maximum pressure cannot increase beyond the maximum pressure limited in that behalf by the certificate issued in respect of the boiler under section 11 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950.
