PURSUANT to the Indecent Publications Act 1910, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Indecent Publications Exemption Notice 1959.

2. The classes of printed matter specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the marking provisions of section 10 of the Indecent Publications Amendment Act 1954.

3. The following notices are hereby revoked:

- (a) The Indecent Publications Exemption Notice 1954.*
- (b) The Indecent Publications Exemption Notice 1955†.
