**THE INCORPORATED SOCIETIES REGULATIONS 1938,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 17th day of March 1954

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Incorporated Societies Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Incorporated Societies Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Incorporated Societies Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1954.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following headings and regulations:

“SHAPE, WRITING, ETC., OF DOCUMENTS TO BE REGISTERED

“12. (1) All documents prepared to be registered, or to be delivered, sent, or forwarded to the Registrar must be legibly and clearly written, typewritten, or printed on paper of foolscap size and of medium weight and good quality, with a margin of at least one-fourth of the width of the paper. Where there are more sheets than one, they must be fastened together with a sufficient paper fastener at the top left-hand corner.

“(2) Carbon copies shall not be received by the Registrar.

“(3) Except by special leave of the Registrar, granted upon such conditions as he thinks fit, no document shall be received by the Registrar which does not comply with this regulation.

## " FEES

" 13. (1) There shall be paid to the Registrar, in respect of the matters mentioned in the Schedule hereto, the fees therein specified.

"(2) Where the Registrar or any other officer is empowered by the said Act to do any act for which a fee is payable, he may refuse to do that act until the fee is paid."

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding the following Schedule:

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations prescribe the form in which documents are to be submitted to the Registrar of Incorporated Societies under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. They also prescribe a new scale of fees payable to the Registrar for various matters under the Act, including a fee, not formerly charged, for filing the annual financial statement. These regulations come into force on 1 April 1954.
