ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of August, 1945

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2), Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2)* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 5.

(2) Regulation 5 of the Licensing Act Emergency Regulations 1942 (No. 2), Amendment No. 2, is hereby consequentially revoked.
