Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Land Acquisition Emergency Regulations 1945,
- 2. The Land Acquisition Emergency Regulations 1942* are hereby revoked.
- 3. (1) In relation to any Proclamation heretofore published in the Gazette taking land under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1928, but not specifying the purpose for which the land or any part thereof was acquired, the Under-Secretary of the Department of Public Works may at any time publish in the Gazette a notice referring to the Proclamation and specifying that purpose.
- (2) The Proclamation so referred to shall at all times thereafter have effect as if the purpose had been specified therein.
- (3) Any notice so published shall be registered in the manner in which a Proclamation is required to be registered by section 28 of the Public Works Act, 1928.
