1 Title

- (1) This determination is the Local Government Elected Members Amendment Determination (No 2) 2004.

3 Schedule 1 amended

The item headed **Auckland Regional Council** is amended by omitting from the second paragraph the expression “\$270,250”, and substituting the expression “\$300,250”.

Explanatory memorandum

This memorandum is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 July 2003, increases the aggregate amount of meeting fees payable to elected members (the **members**) of the Auckland Regional Council for the period of 1 July 2003 to 30 June 2004. The old amount was \$270,250; the new amount is \$300,250.

The Remuneration Authority has agreed that the members should be compensated for additional meetings held for planning the process of the transfer of assets and responsibilities arising out of the enactment of the Local Government (Auckland) Amendment Act 2004. The work by the members to scope and establish the organisational structures and related matters required by the legislation was not known when the original meeting fee pool was established.
