



Land Information New Zealand (Fees and Charges) Amendment Regulations 2004

Pursuant to section 184A of the Land Act 1948 and section 235 of the Land Transfer Act 1952, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

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Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Land Information New Zealand (Fees and Charges) Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Land Information New Zealand (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2003¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 5 July 2004.

3 Schedule amended

Part 3 of the Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from the first column opposite the item relating to providing a copy of a survey plan or diagram the expression “7”, and substituting the expression “4”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 5 July 2004, amend the fee payable to Land Information New Zealand, as set out in Part 3 of the Schedule of the Land Information New Zealand (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2003, for providing a copy of a survey plan or diagram.

The fee is reduced from \$7 to \$4.
