Sections 40 to 44, 92, and 103(1) and (2) of the Land Transport Management Act 2003 come into force on 9 September 2004.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings sections 40 to 44, 92, and 103(1) and (2) of the Land Transport Management Act 2003 into force on 9 September 2004. Among other things, those sections relate to—

- the diversion of prescribed amounts of excise duty and excise-equivalent duty from the Crown Bank Account to the national land transport fund; and
 - refunds of excise duty, excise-equivalent duty, and goods and services tax.
