**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS REGULATIONS 1956,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of July 1959

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 4, and substituting the following regulation:

“4. The names of electors shall be entered on the district electors list in alphabetical order of surnames, and shall be numbered consecutively, or, if the Council so decides, the names on each page of the list shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the number 1 in the case of the first name on that page. In the last-mentioned case the number appearing on the district electors list against the name of any elector, preceded by the number of the page on which his name appears, shall be deemed to be his number on the list.”

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that, where the names of the electors on the district electors list are numbered consecutively by pages, the names of electors entered on each page of the supplementary district electors list shall also be

numbered consecutively beginning with the number 1 in the case of the first name on that page; and in that case the page number of the first page of the supplementary list shall be the number immediately following the number of the last page of the district electors list, or of the last previous supplementary list, as the case may be."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations authorise Borough Councils and Town Councils to number the names of electors on the district electors list either consecutively throughout the list or consecutively by pages. In the latter case, an elector's number on the list will be the number appearing opposite his name, preceded by the number of the page on which his name appears.
