Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, postpones until 31 August 2007 the expiry of the Mental Health Commission Act 1998.

That Act at present provides that it is to expire on 31 August 2004; and the effect of its expiry would be to abolish the Mental Health Commission.
