## THE MORRINSVILLE MILK DISTRICT ORDER 1963

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of September  
1963

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Morrinsville Milk District Order 1963.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Borough of Morrinsville and parts of the County of Piako are hereby constituted and declared a milk district with the name of the Morrinsville Milk District; and the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The Milk Authority for the said district shall be the Morrinsville Borough Council.

4. The Piako County Council shall be entitled to have one representative on the Milk Committee of the Morrinsville Borough Council and from time to time to nominate one person for that purpose.

5. The Morrinsville Borough Council shall from time to time appoint to the Milk Committee of the Borough Council the person nominated by the Piako County Council pursuant to clause 4 hereof.

### SCHEDULE

#### THE MORRINSVILLE MILK DISTRICT

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, County of Piako and Borough of Morrinsville, containing 2,730 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the northernmost corner of Lot 4, D.P. 24498, situated in Block II, Maungakawa Survey District, and proceeding generally south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 4 and Pt Lot 5, D.P. 24498, to and along the north-western boundary of Lot 23, D.P. S. 1162, to a point 5 chains north-westerly from the north-western side of Coronation Road; thence generally

north-easterly along a line distant 5 chains from and parallel to the aforesaid north-western side of Coronation Road, to its intersection with a right line parallel to and 6 chains south-westerly from the south-western side of that road; thence north-westerly along the last-mentioned right line to its intersection with a right line 5 chains north-westerly from and parallel to the north-western side of Coronation Road; thence north-easterly along that right line to its intersection with a right line parallel to and 5 chains north-easterly from the south-western side; thence south-easterly along that right line to the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. S. 2035; thence north-easterly, south-easterly, and south-westerly along the north-western, north-eastern, and south-eastern boundaries of the said Lot 1, to meet the production of the last-mentioned right line; thence south-easterly along that right line produced to its intersection with a right line parallel to and 5 chains north-westwards from the north-western side of State Highway No. 26; thence generally north-easterly along the last-mentioned right line to the middle of the Piako River; thence generally southerly up the middle of that river to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. S. 6988; thence south-westerly to and along the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid Lot 1, to the southernmost corner of that lot; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Te-Au-O-Waikato 7c 3c Block; thence along the north-western boundary of the aforesaid block and its production to the middle of the Topehahae Stream; thence generally northerly down the middle of that stream and the production of that middle line to a point in the middle of the Waitakaruru Stream, situated in Block VI, Maungakawa Survey District; thence generally westerly up the middle of that stream to the western boundary of the aforesaid Block VI; thence northwards along that boundary to and across the Thames Branch Railway and State Highway No. 26, to a point in line with the production of the north-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 24525; thence north-easterly to and along the aforesaid north-western boundary of Lot 3 and its production, to a point 5 chains south-westerly from the south-western side of Avenue Road, on the north-western boundary of Pt Lot 11, D.P. 2465; thence north-westerly along a right line 5 chains distant from and parallel to the aforesaid south-western side of Avenue Road, to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 7A, D.P. 2465; thence north-easterly to and along that north-western boundary and its production, to the north-eastern boundary of Lot 7, D.P. 2465; thence north-westerly along the aforesaid north-eastern boundary to the northernmost corner of the said Lot 7; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 14696, to its intersection with a right line 5 chains south-westerly from and parallel to the south-western side of Studholme Street; thence north-westerly along the aforesaid line to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. S. 524; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary to the northernmost corner of the said Lot 1; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of that lot, to and along the north-western boundaries of Lots 3 and 4, D.P. 24498, to the point of commencement.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order provides for the constitution of a milk district at Morrinsville, and constitutes the Morrinsville Borough Council as the Milk Authority for the district. The Piako County Council is to be entitled to have one representative on the Milk Committee of the Morrinsville Borough Council.
