**THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1942,
AMENDMENT NO. 42**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 42, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The Third Schedule of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 37, and substituting the following:

“SALES AREA 37 (SET OF DIFFERENTIALS APPLICABLE: No. 23)

“All that area in the Gisborne Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point 20 chains north of the Makaraka Post Office and proceeding due east for a distance of 20 chains; thence due south to a

point 100 links north of the Gisborne-Makaraka road; thence easterly along a line parallel to and distant 100 links north of that road to the western boundary of the City of Gisborne; thence northerly, easterly, and southerly along the western, northern, and eastern boundaries of that city to the intersection of the middle lines of Tyndall and Wainui Roads; thence easterly along a right line to the mouth of the Hamanautua Stream; thence southerly and westerly along the sea coast to the southern boundary of the City of Gisborne; thence westerly and northerly along the southern and western boundaries of that city to a point 100 links south of the Gisborne-Makaraka road; thence westerly along a line parallel to and distant 100 links south of that road to a point 20 chains eastward of the Makaraka Post Office; thence due south for a distance of 20 chains; thence due west for a distance of 40 chains; thence due north for a distance of 40 chains; thence easterly along a right line to the point of commencement.

Gisborne Makaraka Wainui”

(b) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 38, and substituting the following:

“SALES AREA 38 (SET OF DIFFERENTIALS APPLICABLE: NO. 27)

“All that area in the Gisborne Land District bounded by a line commencing at the mouth of the Waipaoa River and proceeding north-westerly along a right line to a point 40 chains west of Manutuke Post Office; thence northerly along a right line to a point 40 chains west of Patutahi Post Office; thence north-easterly along a right line to a point on the Gisborne-Motuhora Railway 40 chains north of Ormond Railway Station; thence easterly along a right line to a point 40 chains south of Waimata Valley Post Office; thence south-easterly along a right line to the sea coast at Tatapouri; thence south-westerly generally along the sea coast to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom Sales Area 37 hereinbefore described.

(2) Regulation 11 of the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1, is hereby amended by revoking subparagraphs (c) and (d) of paragraph (i).
