**THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1942,
AMENDMENT NO. 43**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of February 1959

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 43, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Second Schedule of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Motor-Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 31, is hereby further amended by adding to the table of differentials the following item:

3. The Third Schedule of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 19, and substituting the following:

“SALES AREA 19 (SET OF DIFFERENTIALS APPLICABLE: NO. 19)

“All that area in the South Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the mouth of the Waiteti Stream; thence proceeding south-easterly and north-easterly generally along the shore of Lake Rotorua to the mouth of the Ohau Channel; thence due north to its intersection with a line parallel to and distant 100 links north of the Hamurana-Mourea Road; thence north-easterly along lines parallel to and distant 100 links north of the Hamurana-Mourea Road to a point due west of the junction of the said road with the Rotorua-Paengaroa State Highway; thence due east to the shore of Lake Rotoiti; thence southerly generally along the shore of that lake to a point due east of the north-eastern corner of Whakapoungakau No. 1B 1 in Block X, Rotoiti Survey District; thence due west to a point 100 links distant from the generally eastern side of the Rotorua-Paengaroa State Highway; thence southerly generally along lines parallel to and distant 100 links east of the eastern side of the said highway to its intersection with the boundary of the Borough of Rotorua; thence southerly, westerly and northerly generally along the generally eastern, southern, and western boundaries of that borough to a point 100 links west of the western side of the Rotorua-Ngongotaha Road; thence northerly generally along lines parallel to and distant 100 links west of the western side of that road to its intersection with the middle of the Ngongotaha Stream; thence up the middle of that stream for a distance of 40 chains; thence due north to the middle of the Waiteti Stream; thence down the middle of that stream to its mouth, the point of commencement.

- (b) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 21, and substituting the following:

“SALES AREA 21 (SET OF DIFFERENTIALS APPLICABLE: NO. 27)

“All that area in the South Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point 40 chains due north of Mamaku Post Office; thence proceeding north-easterly along a right line to a point 40 chains due north of Hamurana Post Office; thence due east along a right line for a distance of 40 chains; thence due south along a right line to a point 100 links north of the Hamurana-Mourea Road; thence easterly along lines parallel to and distant 100 links north of that road to a point due west of the junction of the said road with the Rotorua-Paengaroa State Highway; thence due east to the shore of Lake Rotoiti; thence southerly and easterly generally along the shore of that lake to a point due north of Rotoiti Post Office; thence due east for a distance of 40 chains; thence due south for a distance of 40 chains; thence southerly along a right line to a point 40 chains due east of Reporoa Post Office; thence due south for a distance of 40 chains; thence due west to the Waitapu River; thence north-westerly along a right

line to a point 40 chains due south of Mamaku Post Office; thence due west for a distance of 40 chains; thence due north for a distance of 80 chains; thence due east to the point of commencement, excluding therefrom areas 19 and 20.

- (c) By omitting from that part of the Schedule that relates to Sales Area 20 the words “Set of Differentials Applicable No. 28”, and substituting the words “Set of Differentials Applicable: No 46”, and by omitting the word “Turukinga”, and substituting the word “Tarukenga”.
