THE MEAT REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 10

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 17th day of November 1959

Present:

THE HON. C. F. SKINNER, M.C., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause 10 : 5 of regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the table set out in subparagraph (vi) of paragraph (a), and substituting the following table:
