**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 24th day of September 1990

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.

**2. Fees**—(1) Regulation 3 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “under section 14 or”, and substituting the words “for a licence (within the meaning of the Game Regulations 1975) under those regulations or an application under”.

(2) Regulation 3 (5) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “under section 14,” and substituting the words “for a licence (within the meaning of the Game Regulations 1975) under those regulations or an application under”.

**3. Levies**—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) Notwithstanding subclause (2) of this regulation, no levy shall be paid in respect of any animal if no part of it has been found fit for human consumption.”

**4. New schedules substituted**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1) and the Second Schedule, and substituting the schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

**5. Amendments to Game Regulations 1975**—(1) The Game Regulations 1975 are hereby amended by—

(a) Omitting from regulations 9 (1) (c), 11 (2), 28, and 31 (2) the words “prescribed fee”, and substituting in each case the words “fee prescribed in that behalf by regulations made under the Meat Act 1981”; and

(b) Revoking regulation 34.

(2) The Game Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2 are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1990, increase the amount of the levy payable under the Meat Act 1981, make clear that the levy is not payable in respect of animals found unfit for human consumption, and also make clear that the application fee for a licence under the Game Regulations 1975 is prescribed not by those regulations but by the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990.
