**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Regulations 1949\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 20 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 5 (1) of the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 5) is hereby amended by adding, as subclause (2), the following subclause:

“(2) The provisions of subclause (1) of this regulation shall not apply to any motor vehicle in respect of which registration plates bearing the distinguishing marks prescribed by regulation 9 (1) (a) of these regulations have been issued if there is affixed to the motor vehicle in the prescribed manner the prescribed form of licence to use the motor vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used.”

The purpose of these regulations is to permit motorcars which have been issued with permanent registration plates to retain those plates in cases where the use of the vehicles is changed.
