**THE NEW ZEALAND GROWN VEGETABLES REGULATIONS
1952, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of May 1959

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Grown Vegetables Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Grown Vegetables Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs:

“(d) Being a package other than of a type prescribed in the said Schedule, contains not less than 2 lb nor more than 15 lb weight of tomatoes, and has clearly stamped thereon the net weight of the contents:

“(e) Being a package not otherwise permitted under these regulations, is approved in writing by the Director for experimental purposes:

“Provided that the use of any such package shall be subject to such conditions relating to size, material, and number of packages as the Director may decide.”

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(d) Are sold by a grower directly to a consumer, and delivery of the tomatoes is made by the grower either at his garden or at the premises of the consumer.”

4. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 13, and substituting the following regulation:

"13. Except as otherwise provided in these regulations, no person shall sell any tomatoes in any container of a type which does not conform to one or other of the types prescribed by these regulations."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 amends regulation 8 of the principal regulations and enables tomatoes to be sold in smaller packages provided the weight of the contents is stamped thereon and also enables the Director of the Horticulture Division to approve, for experimental purposes, containers which are not otherwise permitted under the regulations.

Regulation 3 amends regulation 11 of the principal regulations and permits a producer to deliver tomatoes to a consumer at his premises under the same conditions as those under which the producer is permitted to sell at his garden.

The amendment to regulation 13 of the principal regulations is consequential on the amendments to regulations 8 and 11.
