THE NIUE (NEW ZEALAND LAWS) REGULATIONS 1972

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of July 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Niue Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Niue (New Zealand Laws) Regulations 1972.

2. Oil in Navigable Waters Act in force in Niue—(1) The Oil in Navigable Waters Act 1965 shall be in force in Niue.

(2) In the application of that Act to Niue, the term “New Zealand” as used in that Act shall both in New Zealand and in Niue be read as including Niue.

3. Section 5 of Western Samoa Act in force in Niue—Section 5 of the Western Samoa Act 1961 shall be in force in Niue as if the reference in that section to New Zealand were a reference to Niue.
