ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of
November, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and for the purpose of consolidating certain Orders in Council heretofore in force and making additional provision, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act Extension Order 1945.
2. The Orders in Council mentioned in the First Schedule hereto are revoked.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1945.
4. The diseases mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be diseases within the meaning of the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928.
5. The First Schedule to the said Act is hereby extended by including therein the diseases mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto.
