



THE OFFENSIVE TRADES NOTICE 1945

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Health Act, 1920, and for the purpose of incorporating and extending a certain notice heretofore given, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Offensive Trades Notice 1945.
2. This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after notification hereof in the *Gazette*.
3. This notice incorporates and extends the notice bearing date the 15th day of December, 1936, and published in the Statutory Regulations of 1936–37 under Serial number 92/1936.
4. The trades, businesses, manufactures, and undertakings described in the Schedule hereto are declared to be offensive trades within the meaning of the Health Act, 1920.

SCHEDULE

THE slaughtering of animals for any purpose other than human consumption.

Fish-cleaning.

Carpet-beating.

Wood-pulping.

Flax-pulping.

Refining of fuel oils.

Refining of lubricating-oils.

Reconditioning of fuel oils.

Reconditioning of lubricating-oils.

Boiling of linseed-oil.

Varnish-manufacture.
