PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Pharmacy Amendment Act Commencement Order 1996.
- 2. Commencement of Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994—The Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994 shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1996.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 1 July 1996, the Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994. That Act is brought into force as a consequence of the commencement, on 1 July 1996, of Part IV of the Health and Disability Commissioner Act 1994, and the Health and Disability Commissioner (Code of Health and Disability Services Consumers' Rights) Regulations 1996.
