**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Pharmacy Amendment Act Commencement Order 1996.

**2. Commencement of Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994**—The Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994 shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1996.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 1 July 1996, the Pharmacy Amendment Act 1994. That Act is brought into force as a consequence of the commencement, on 1 July 1996, of Part IV of the Health and Disability Commissioner Act 1994, and the Health and Disability Commissioner (Code of Health and Disability Services Consumers' Rights) Regulations 1996.
