ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of February 1983

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Pesticides Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Pesticides Act Commencement Order 1983.

2. Commencement of Act—(1) Part V of the Pesticides Act 1979 (comprising sections 42 to 54, and relating to controlled pesticides), and the First Schedule to that Act, shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1983.

(2) The Pesticides Act 1979, except Part II (which came into force on the 1st day of August 1981*), Part V, and the said First Schedule, shall come into force on the 11th day of March 1983.
