THE POSTAL AMENDING REGULATIONS 1938 (NO. 2).
GALWAY, Governor-General.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.
At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 17 th day of December, 1938.

Present:
The Right Hon. M. J. Savage presiding in Council.
Pursuant to the power and authority vested in him by the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1938 (No. 2).
2. The rates prescribed in the respective regulations made under the said Act and referred to in the First Schedule hereto are revoked so far as they relate to inland parcels, fragile parcels, packets (comprising commercial papers, books, and printed papers, patterns and sample packets, and unregistered magazines), and Government packages sent by book-post.
3. The rates of postage on commercial papers, printed papers, packets, pattern and sample packets, and parcels in the inland post and sample packets in the overseas post shall be those set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

## (e) Express Transit Fee.

PAYABLE FOR SURFACE TRANSPORT ONLY.
(i) For parcels containing cinematograph films, for each film (including a
trailer film) in the container

(ii) For any other parcel (in addition to fragile fee, if payable) .. .. 6d.

The fees prescribed for air transport include express transit (without additional fee) by surface transport for any portion of the route over which air transport is not available.

COMMERCIAL PAPERS AND PRINTED PAPERS.
For each 2 oz. or fraction thereof up to $1 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{lb}$. .. .. .. $0 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$.
(Articles exceeding $1 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{lb}$. shall be charged for at parcel rates.)
