## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the power and authority vested in him by the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Postal-note Amending Regulations 1939.

2. Regulation 4 of the regulations made on the 16th day of December, 1907, and published in the *Gazette* on the 31st day of the same month at page 3591 (as heretofore amended), is revoked, and the following substituted :--

"Every postal-note shall be numbered, and shall be for one of the following amounts, and in respect of each postal-note the following poundage shall be paid :-
