

# THE POSTAL AMENDING REGULATIONS 1948

Pursuant to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1948.
2. The Amending Postal Regulations made on the 15th day of August, 1927,* are amended by revoking Regulation 5 under the heading "Insured Box Service", and substituting the following regulation :-
" 5 . The postage and insurance fees on an insured box shall be fully prepaid. The postage-rate shall be 2 d . for each 2 oz ., with a minimum charge of 10 d . The insurance fees shall be the same as those in respect, of insured letters. The limit of insurance shall be $£ 400$."
3. The regulations relating to small packets made on the 18th day of June, $1934 \dagger$, are amended by revoking Regulation 2 thereof, and substituting the following regulation :-

- " 2. The postage on small packets shall be 1 d . for each 2 oz . or fraction thereof, with a minimum charge of 6 d ., and the maximum weight of a small packet shall be 2 lb ."

4. The Second Schedule to the Postal Amending Regulations 1939 (No. 1$) \ddagger$ is amended by making in the respective items thereof the alterations hereinafter set out, namely :-
(i) Letters

1 (a). Delete " half-ounce", and substitute " ounce".
2. Delete "Egypt and Iraq".

2 (a). Delete " 2 d . for the first half-ounce and 1d. for each additional half-ounce", and substitute " 2 d. for the first ounce and 1d. for each additional ounce."
3. Delete "(except Egypt and Iraq)".

3 (a). Delete " 3 d . for the first half-ounce and 1 d . for each additional half-ounce", and substitute " 3 d . for the first ounce and $1 \frac{1}{2} d$. for each additional ounce."
(ii) Post-cards
2. Delete " Egypt and Iraq".
3. Delete " (except Egypt and Iraq) ".
(iii) Commercial Papers

Overseas: Delete " $2 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$. .", and substitute " 3 d. ."
(iv) Printed Papers

Overseas: Delete " 4 oz.", "and substitute " 2 oz. .". Delete " 4 lb .", and substitute " $6 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{lb}$.".
(v) Printed Papers

Overseas: Delete " 4 oz .", and substitute " 2 oz .". Delete " 4 lb.", and substitute " $6 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{lb}$.".
(vi) Packets (including patterns and samples)

Overseas (samples only): Delete" 2 d . for the first $4 \mathrm{oz} . ; 1 \mathrm{~d}$. each additional 2 oz .", and substitute " 1 d . for first 2 oz ; $\frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$. each additional 2 oz .".
(vii) Registered Newspapers

Foreign countries: Delete "each copy: $\frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$. for each 2 oz." and substitute " each copy: 1d. for the first 2 oz . and $\frac{1}{2} \mathrm{~d}$. each additional 2 oz.".
