THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1952.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1952.

2. The Second Schedule to the Postal Amending Regulations 1939 (No. 1),* as substituted by regulation 8 of the Postal Amending Regulations 1950†, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) By omitting from Item 1 the words “ 3d. for each half ounce ”, and substituting the words “ 4d. for each half ounce ”:
- (b) By omitting from Item 4 the words “ 1d. for each half ounce ”, and substituting the words “ 2d. for each half ounce ”.
